

# **Indian Prairie Educational Foundation Frequently Asked Questions**

## **Beauty and the Beast at the Neuqua Valley High School Auditorium March 10, 2012, 1 p.m.**

### **HOW CAN I GET TICKETS FOR THE PERFORMANCE?**

The recommended method is to send an order form, **along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope**, to the project chair Peg Ehrisman, 1243 Redfield Road, Naperville, IL 60563. Order forms are available at [www.204foundation.org](http://www.204foundation.org). **Please remember to send a self addressed, stamped envelope with your order form.**

### **CREDIT CARDS are NOT ACCEPTED.**

Orders are filled on a first come, first served basis, and must be received at the address above by Friday, February 24. A limited number of tickets are available in the main office at Neuqua Valley High School. They can be purchased in the administration office between 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. on days when students are in attendance. As you enter the building through the main entrance, the main office is on your right.

If all tickets are not pre-sold, they will be available at the box office at NVHS beginning at 11 a.m. on the day of the performance.

### **WHAT HAPPENS IF I SEND IN AN ORDER FORM AND CHECK AND THE TICKETS ARE SOLD OUT?**

Your check will be voided and returned to you in the self-addressed, stamped envelope that you sent with your order. If it is very close to the performance date, you will be called at the contact phone number on the order form, to let you know in advance that you did not get tickets.

### **ARE SEATS RESERVED?**

Seats are not reserved. We suggest that large groups arrive early if they want to be seated together. We will attempt to accommodate their seating needs. Doors to the theatre open at 12:15.

### **FOR WHAT AGE GROUP IS THE PERFORMANCE APPROPRIATE AND HOW LONG DOES IT LAST?**

Generally, AlphaBet Soup performances are appropriate for adults and children of all ages, assuming they can sit through a 75-minute performance without an intermission.

### **DO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS PERFORM THE PLAY?**

The Indian Prairie Educational Foundation hires a professional theatrical production company, AlphaBet Soup Productions, for the performance. The actors are professionals.

### **ARE THERE ROOMS AVAILABLE FOR BIRTHDAY PARTIES?**

No. The Foundation contracts for the auditorium only. Liability insurance requirements and other activities taking place at the school prohibit the availability of rental space at the school itself.

### **WHEN WILL THE NEXT PERFORMANCE BE HELD?**

Our arrangement with AlphabetSoup calls for a November performance at Waubonsie Valley High School, a December holiday program at Metea Valley High School, and a March performance at Neuqua Valley High School. Each performance begins at 1:00. AlphaBet Soup's schedule and other commitments allow for only one performance on each day.

### **DO YOUNG CHILDREN AND/OR DISTRICT 204 EMPLOYEES NEED A TICKET?**

Everyone needs to purchase a ticket, including toddlers and school district employees.
