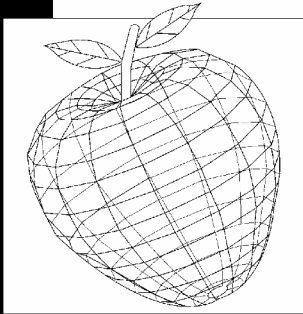


**INDIAN PRAIRIE
